CHAPTER 11

LIQUOR LICENSING

**SECTION I. LICENSE RESTRICTIONS-DELINQUENT TAXES, ETC.**

- A. PREMISES. No initial or renewal alcohol beverage license shall be granted for any premises for which taxes, assessments or other claims for the Town of Glenmore are delinquent and unpaid.
- B. PERSONS. No initial or renewal alcohol license shall be granted to any person:
  - 1. Delinquent in payment of any taxes, assessments or other claims owed to the Town of Glenmore.
  - 2. Delinquent in payment of a forfeiture resulting from a violation of any ordinance of the Town of Glenmore.
  - 3. Delinquent in payment to the County of Brown or to the State of Wisconsin of any taxes owed.

**SECTION II. PROVISIONAL OPERATOR'S LICENSE**

A. This ordinance allows for the issuance of a Provisional Operators License to eligible persons while they are obtaining proof of:

1) completion of a responsible beverage service course

OR

2) prior licensing by a Wisconsin municipality within the past two year period.

B. Applicant must comply with Wisconsin Statutes concerning Operator eligibility.

C. Clerk may issue Provisional Operators License for a 30 day period without prior Town Board Approval. License will be void after the period stated on license, and will not be renewable.

D. Provisional Operators License will be replaced with an Operators License provided the applicant issues the Town Clerk ONE of the following:

1) Proof applicant has successfully completed the required Responsible Beverage Service Course.

2) Statement of prior operator's licensing in a Wisconsin municipality within the last two year period as verified by issuing Clerk.

3) The sum of \$5.00 is required to be paid by or for the applicant prior to license issuance. Operators License will be issued to replace the Provisional Operators License at no additional charge once the proper documentation is provided.
