ELECTORS' ADOPTION OF THE TOWN TAX LEVY AT SPECIAL TOWN MEETING OF THE ELECTORS

Whereas, s. 60.10 (1)(a) of Wis. Statutes authorizes the town electors of a town to adopt the town tax levy at a town meeting of the electors;

Whereas, a special town meeting of the electors has been called for this 17th day of November, 2015;

Whereas, the electors, after proper notice, have with a special town meeting vote, authorized the Town of Glenmore to exceed the allowable state levy limit;


Now, therefore, the special town meeting of the Town of Glenmore, Brown County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the eligible electors voting on this 17th day of November, 2015 duly assembled and voting resolves and orders as follows:


BE IT RESOLVED, the town electors of the Town of Glenmore, Brown County, Wisconsin hereby adopt the town tax levy for 2015 to be collected in 2016 in the amount of \$492,648.

The town clerk shall properly post this resolution in 3 places as required by law under s. 60.80 of Wis. Statutes within 30 days of adoption.
